For men, defusing those loaded questions

Making the rounds on the Inter-net is an unattributed list of "The five questions most feared by men."

These questions are:

- 1. What are you thinking about?**
- 2. Do you love me?**
- 3. Do I look fat?**
- 4. Do you think she is prettier than I am?**
- 5. What would you do if I died?**

What makes these questions so difficult is that every one is guaranteed to explode into a major argument if the man answers incorrectly (i.e., tells the truth).
